DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES

Entries should be postmarked no later than May 15, 2009.
New entries will be accepted after that date,
however **NO new divisions will be opened.**

REGISTRATION FEE

A \$35.00 Registration fee is required of all participants.
Each competition division entered (modeling and talent) is
\$10.00 each. Cameo Girl Pageant is \$35.00.

AGE DIVISIONS

Girls: The competition divisions will be broken into the
following age categories (modeling and talent): 3-4, 5-6, 7-8,
9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15-17, 18-26, 26 and over. Any age
category with less than three (3) participants will be
combined with another age division. Note: The age division
you will be in is the age you are the day of the competition.

Boys: Same age groups for Talents but for Modeling it
will be 3-12 years and 13 yr. and above. (Only two groups -
but all categories)

AWARDS

1st, 2nd, and 3rd place medallion awards will be presented
in each category. CAMEO Girl will place through 4th
alternate, and crowns and banners will be awarded to Model
of the Year and Talent of the year. Cameo Girls will also
receive a **\$75.00 Savings Bonds for each Cameo
Winner in the 8 age categories**

ORDER OF EVENTS

The competition will be conducted in the order as listed on the
entry blank.

TALENT COMPETITION

The special talent competition is designed to encourage talent
training for the modeling profession, pageant participant and careers
in the performing arts. Entrants may enter as many talent
categories as they desire, however, they may NOT enter more than
one talent act within a category. The AAMTC talent score sheet
(which will be received by each participant) is an invaluable aid in
preparing for state pageant competitions, dance recitals, etc.

TALENT REQUIREMENTS

Talent presentations should be about 2 minutes in length. Props are
acceptable. A microphone (stand and hand) will be available. Any
other equipment will be the participant's responsibility. No type of
fire act or special lighting effects will be allowed. Note: Only one
talent selection should be recorded on a single CD.

TALENT CDs

Entrants may enter as many talent events as they wish, however,
**EACH TAPED NUMBER MUST BE THE ONLY
RECORDING ON A CD FOR EACH EVENT.** Maximum time
is 2:30 minutes - recommended time is 2 minutes. All talents will
be timed and overtime is grounds for disqualification.

MODELING

All AAMTC modeling presentations will be done to official music.
Routines will be judged on modeling style, entrance and exit, a
variety of turns, and the necessary detailing and interpretation of
garment. Smoothness, flow, showmanship and sales ability are all
prerequisites for a good model.

MODELING PROCEDURE

AAMTC modeling is free style and there is no set pattern for
presentations. The only requirement is that the participants begin
their modeling presentations at Position 1 and that they reach the
final position, Position 4, before the end of the final harp sweep.

PHOTOGENIC DIVISION

Judged on photogenic qualities from a photograph. Bring photo on
day of competition. **DO NOT MAIL.** Photo may be black and
white, or color in any size up to, and no larger than 8" X 10".
Photos will be returned. They will be judged on photographic
beauty, mood, or expression and quality of photograph.

OFFICIAL AAMTC MODELING MUSIC The official AAMTC
runway/modeling music is used at all AAMTC events. The music is
precisely timed to give equal presentation time to each competitor.
The forty musical selections, professionally recorded with a full
studio orchestra have an electronic warning 10-seconds before the
end of the music. There is an additional 5-second harp sweep for
the participant to complete the modeling presentation. A modeling
demonstration will be held prior to the competition to ensure that
each contestant understands the procedure, however, AAMTC
modeling is "free style" and the participant may use any modeling
pattern so long as the presentation is completed by the end of the
final harp sweep.

WHAT IS AAMTC

The America's Amateur Modeling and Talent Competition is
dedicated to the advancement of the modeling and talent
fields through competitive events, the establishment of

professional ethics and the standardization of training. The
association is open to all amateur and professional models
and/or those engaged in the performing arts, regardless of
their affiliation with any other modeling or talent association,
beauty pageant or trade union.

METHOD OF ADJUDICATION

AAMTC is NOT a beauty contest; however, good grooming
and overall appearance will be taken into consideration.

Modeling will be judged on: (1) Posture and Body
Alignment, (2) Walk and Movements, (3) Interpretation of
Garment, (4) Presentation, (5) Composition of the Routine.
Talent will be judged on: (1) Appearance, (2)
Composition of the Routine, (3) Variety and Difficulty, (4)
Execution, (5) Presentation.

**Only in Cameo Girl will physical beauty
be taken into consideration.**

OVERALL "AAMTC MODEL OF THE YEAR" AWARDS

To qualify for the overall modeling awards, a participant must have
entered the Partywear category and any other four modeling
categories of their choice (minimum: 5 modeling categories). Points
from the required category and the four highest points from other
categories entered (you may enter as many categories as you
desire) will be tabulated in the following manner: Each 1st place-3
pts: each 2nd place-2 pts: each 3rd place-1 pt. The participant
accumulating the most points in each age category will be awarded
the official "AAMTC MODEL OF THE YEAR" title, banner, trophy
and crown. (A "model-off" in the outfit of your choice will be held in
the event of a tie to the official AAMTC Modeling Music).
Note: Judges decisions are final and please refer to your comment
sheets for critiques.

OVERALL "AAMTC TALENT OF THE YEAR" AWARDS

To qualify for the overall talent awards, a participant must enter a
minimum of three (3) solo talent categories. The highest points from
3 talent categories entered (you may enter as many categories as
you desire) will be tabulated as follows: Each 1st place-3 pts: each
2nd place-2 pts: each 3rd place-1 pt. The participant with the highest
number of points in each age category will be awarded the official
"AAMTC TALENT OF THE YEAR" title, banner, trophy and crown.
(In the event of a tie, those making the tie will perform the talent of
their choice to determine the winner).
Note: Judges decisions are final and please refer to your comment
sheets for critiques.
